Registration Made Easy!

In order to view the Kimball Classmate Directory and edit your personal profile, you'll need to register. It only takes a minute.

The registration process requires two steps:
Registration, and
Activation:

1. Register -- click on the NEW! Registration and Classmate Directory link on the website home page to get to the registration form. Enter your full first and last graduating name -- no nicknames. If your name includes a "Jr." or "III", include that as part of your last name, separated by a space -- don't use any

punctuation, such as a comma or period. Enter your email address, your desired password (twice, for confirmation), and click on the Submit button.

2. Look for your **Registration Activation** email to arrive shortly in your Inbox. Clicking on the http://activation link contained in the email will bring up a screen that asks you to enter your password. Enter the same password that you created during registration, and click the Activate button at the bottom of the screen. You'll then be automatically logged in, and your profile page will be displayed for you to update your personal

information.

Once you've completed the registration process, you'll be "remembered" the next time you visit the web site, making it unnecessary for you to login. So, for example, the next time you visit the site and click on the Classmate Directory link, you'll be taken directly to the Classmate Directory Database Search feature, bypassing login. However, if you logout (by clicking on the logout link), or if you're using a different computer, you'll need to login again by entering your email address and password.

After getting logged in, click on the "Update Profile" link at the bottom of the Database Search page. There you'll be able to enter your profile information in several data categories (general, family, memories, questions), upload your "then" and "now" pictures, and set your profile preferences. Be sure to click on the Submit button at the bottom of each page to save your entries before selecting a different data category.


